## Awards:

- CAJC, BOJ, CAC CR, R. CAC CR, CAC CMKU, CACIB FCI, Res. CACIB FCI, BOB, BOS, BOV.
- The awards Czech Champion and International Champion are subject to the issued provisions.
- **Saturday – Grand Prix of National Breeds** – all dogs of Czech national breeds, both FCI-recognized and not-recognized, incl. československý vlčák, participate in the defile. In the final contest, only dogs having obtained BOB compete.
- Junior handling I. and II. category, Best Couple, Best kennel, Best veteran, Best puppy, Show of honor class, JBOD (-Best junior dog), BIG, BOD, BIS, JBIS.
- Best Couple – a male and a female of the same breed and variety presented at the show, owned or co-owned by the same person(s). The co-ownership must be confirmed by a record in the pedigree.
- Best Kennel – minimum three individuals of the same breed and variety, which have been judged at the show, which come from the same kennel and which have at least two different or mothers.

## Veterinary conditions:

- All the entered dogs must be clinically healthy.
- Dogs must have pet passport or veterinary certificate with valid vaccination against rabies.
- Dogs from EU and from third countries must have valid EU Pet Passport and must meet the conditions by the EU Regulation 998/2003 from 26/5/2003.
- All the time during the dog show the owners must supervise / take care of the dogs so that they do not cause any damage to other dogs or humans.

## General provisions:

The dog show is organized according to the dog shows rules of the FCI and CMKU. Only dogs entered in FCI-accepted stud books are allowed to take part at the show. Dogs which have reached the age required for entering the desired class on the show day at the latest. Division into classes is according by the FCI Show Regulation and is described in the registration form. The organizer of the show is not responsible for any damages caused by the dog or by the exhibitor neither for death nor for loss of the dog. **Dogs with cropped ears are not allowed into the show grounds and will not be judged.**

It is forbidden to prepare a dog with any substance that will alter the structure, colour or form of the coat, skin or nose. Only trimming, clipping, combing and brushing are allowed. It is also

forbidden to leave the dog tied up on the trimming table, longer than necessary for the preparation. The violation of these rules can lead to disqualification of the dog. Owners of the dogs awarded the title BOB (Best of Breed) are obliged to participate with their dogs in the final competitions. The exhibitors are obliged to abide with the provisions of the FCI Show Regulations, of these propositions and the instructions of the Show Committee to which they bind themselves by submitting the entry form. They are also obliged to maintain the exhibition area clean. In case the show does not take place for objective reasons, the fees would be used for covering the show preparation expenses. It is forbidden to bring puppies for the purpose of sale to the show. The organizer does not accept any responsibility for undelivered applications. Documents submitted after the 3<sup>rd</sup> entry deadline will not be taken into consideration. An exhibitor agrees with publication of his address in the show catalogue and on the web page of Intercanis.

## Instructions for application completion:

Complete the application on a typewriter or in block capitals. Illegible application forms will be returned. The organizer accepts no responsibility for wrongly completed applications. Unless a photocopy of Performance Certificate (the examination certificate, not tables and exam confirmation or Championship, Certificate for the Champion class) is enclosed the dog will be classified to the open class. A proof of fee payment has to be attached to the application, unless the application will be returned. The fee may be paid at the show in exceptional situations upon agreement with the organizer, as per the 3<sup>rd</sup> deadline. The postal date on envelope is decisive for distinction between the first, second and third deadlines. Reclassification or exclusion of dogs after the deadline is not possible. Acceptance of a dog to the show will be confirmed in written 10 days before the show (letter or by e-mail). By application acceptance each exhibitor is subject to all the provisions of the FCI Exhibition Rule and the internal rules. Important note: A photocopy of the pedigree has to be attached to the application – applies to all the dogs admitted to the exhibition.

## Protest:

A protest against any decision made by the judge is not admissible. A protest can be submitted for formal reasons such as violation of the show regulation provisions and proposition provisions. The protest must be submitted in written form, against a deposit of 1600 CZK, during the course of the show. If protest is found to be unjustified, this deposit will be forfeited to the organizer of the show.
