



## CV – K.S. Wilberg

I was born in Norway in 1944, and came into dogs when I was 15 years old. I have judged at championship level since 1967 and I judge regularly all over the world.

I married into Poodles because my wife was a founder member of the Norwegian Poodle club and its chairman for a few years.

In Norway we, made up champions in Poodle, Bouvier, German Shepherd, Welsh Corgi Pembroke, Scottish Terrier,

Schnauzer, Keeshond, Dachshund and Boxer. We were Norway's top winning Boxer and Bouvier kennel in most of the seventies and early eighties until we moved to the UK.

We moved to England in 1982, and have made up champions in Boxer, Giant Schnauzer, Standard Schnauzer, Miniature Schnauzer, Bouviers and Min Wire Dachshunds and Pointers, 57 in all.

In 1998 we had runner up all breeds in the UK with the Bouvier Ch Kanix Zulu which is our top show dog of all time. He has won 33 CCs, 23 Groups, 9 BIS and 6 RBIS at all breed championship show. He was also runner up all breeds in 1999. He is now regarded as one of the top show dogs of all time in the UK. His sister Ch Kanix Zena won the working Group at Crufts in 1998.

My main Breed is now Pointers and it is 8 English champions carrying our prefix, which is Kanix.

Before we moved to the UK I was a board member of the Norwegian Kennel Club and a member of NKK's Show Committee.

Under the FCI rules I am passed to give CCs to all breeds. I have judged dogs in all corners of the world.
