In addition to breeding and showing Vizslas, Miguel enjoyed tremendous success with the breeding and campaigning of his Pointers, Doberman's and Setters as well as his Vizslas. After much show ring success, Miguel's judging career commenced and it has taken him around the world several times over, seeing him visit most countries numerous times in all continents. He has judged at many FCI World Dog Shows and was the President of the FCI 2005 World Dog Show, Buenos Aires. An FCI all breeds judge who embraces each assignment with great enthusiasm in his inimitable style. Currently, Miguel is a member of the FCI's General Committee. Also, he is the current President of the Federación Cinológica Argentina.
